

Ajax Wishlist Panel for Magento 2

Installation Guide

Installation

1. First of all, back up your store database and web directory. It is wise to perform this procedure before any installation.
2. Unpack the extension files and copy these to **/app/code** directory. If you don't have a **/code** folder under **/app** folder, simply create one.
3. Run the following command in your shell from your Magento root directory to make sure all setup scripts are working:

php -f bin/magento setup:upgrade

4. Refresh cache via admin end. Then go to the Magento root folder and find **pub/static/frontend/** folder. Delete everything inside this folder. Then go to the Magento root folder again and find **pub/static/adminhtml/** and delete everything inside this folder. Make sure you don't delete htaccess file in **/pub** folder.
5. Run Magento compile command:

php bin/magento setup:di:compile






6. Deploy static content:

php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

7. Reindex data:

php -f bin/magento indexer:reindex

8. To enable the extension, go to System->Web Setup Wizard->Component Manager in Magento store admin panel. Then find the Orange35/Wishlistpanel in the list, select Enable in the dropdown and perform the required steps:
